

CIRC Batadrava Completed Student Summer Camp- 2014

CIRC Batadrava, the youngest CIRC completed student summer camp with 60 students. It was the first initiative of CIRC with student of government school. The duration of the programme was three week. The centre took the initiative with local school. It was such a programme where concept of Integrated Technology Education (ITE) was introduced for the first time in a place like Batadrava.
