



Digitalsarthak

Digital Sarthak is a national digital entrepreneurship and empowerment programme of Digital Empowerment Foundation supported by USAID and DAI.

The main objective of the project is to increase the digital capacity of the Women entrepreneurs and community development organizations in marginalized and underserved regions in India by providing them with digital up-skilling support and strengthening their ability to engage on digital and ICT policy issues.



The project is designed to enable 10,000 women entrepreneurs to connect online by facilitating digital access and use the digital tool safely, securely and impactfully. The project also aims to enable 500 women-led Community Development Organizations (CDO's) to outreach effectively and translate their management system online.

The program also established 100 digital resource centres equipped with a multi-function printer and a smartphone with the help of Digital Sarthaks, covering 50 blocks and 1500 villages located in selected aspirational districts to build the capacity of the women entrepreneurs and CDOs. With the establishment of the centers, the project aims to connect 300,000 individuals with relevant schemes and entitlements, and digitally enable 100,000 individuals with digital and financial literacy.
